2. LINE

A 5 meter sample of the actual line used must be submitted with the claim. (The sample need not include the double line).

3. TIME LIMIT

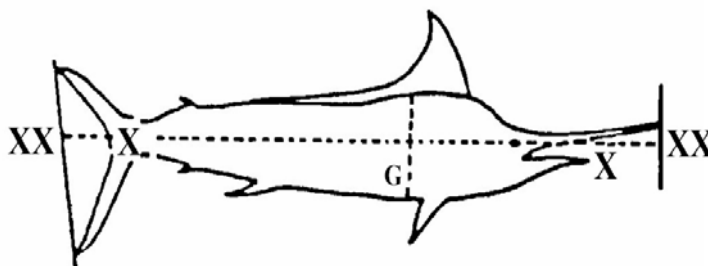
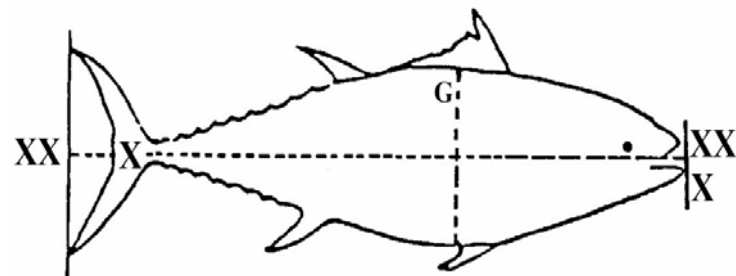
Claims must be received by the Hon. Secretary of K.A.S.A. within sixty days of the date of catch or they cannot be accepted.

4. TRACE or LEADER

The length of the trace or leader is the overall length including any lure, hook arrangement or other device.

5. SPECIES MEASUREMENTS

Measure as indicated below, taking lengths from X to X and from XX to XX.
Take girth around the fish on line marked G or at largest dimension location.
